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1. Context

1.1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to highlight the burglaries that have occurred across the London Borough of Redbridge between December 2017 and November 2018. Statistics show that during this period there were 3007¹ burglaries in Redbridge that were reported to and recorded by the Metropolitan Police. This document shows where the burglaries have taken place and breaks down the overall total by presenting it monthly on 12 maps.

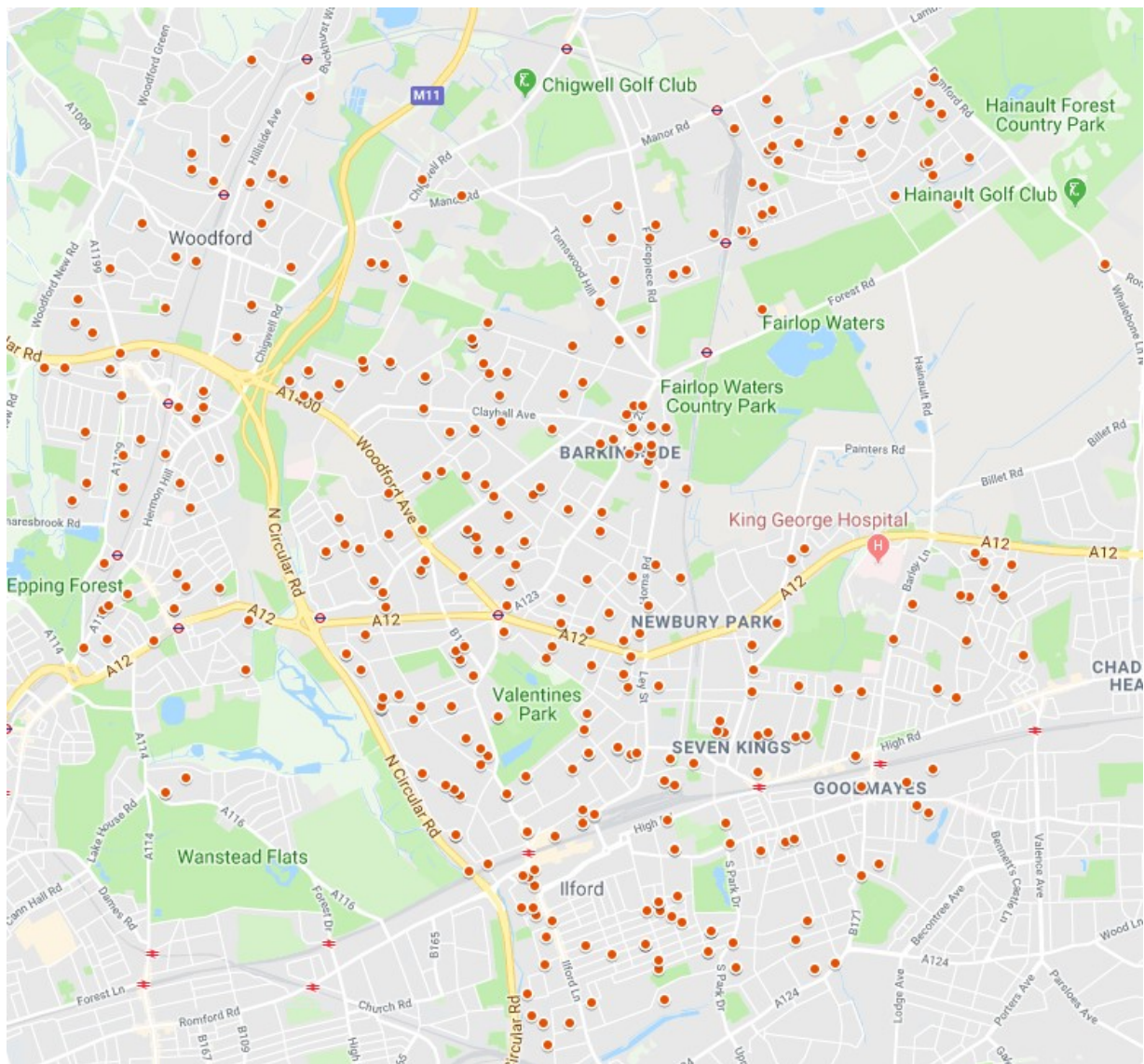
Although the map pinpoints locations, the purpose is not to highlight any specific property that has been the subject to a burglary, but rather highlight the road where a burglary has taken place. Where there are multiple pinpoints in close proximity, it is again to not to indicate that a particular property was subject to multiple burglaries but that there have been multiple instances of burglaries on that street within that month not necessarily at that specific pinpoint.

The purpose is also not to provide detailed analysis of each and every burglary but to show the changing state of affairs over the period in order to support discussion and decision making.

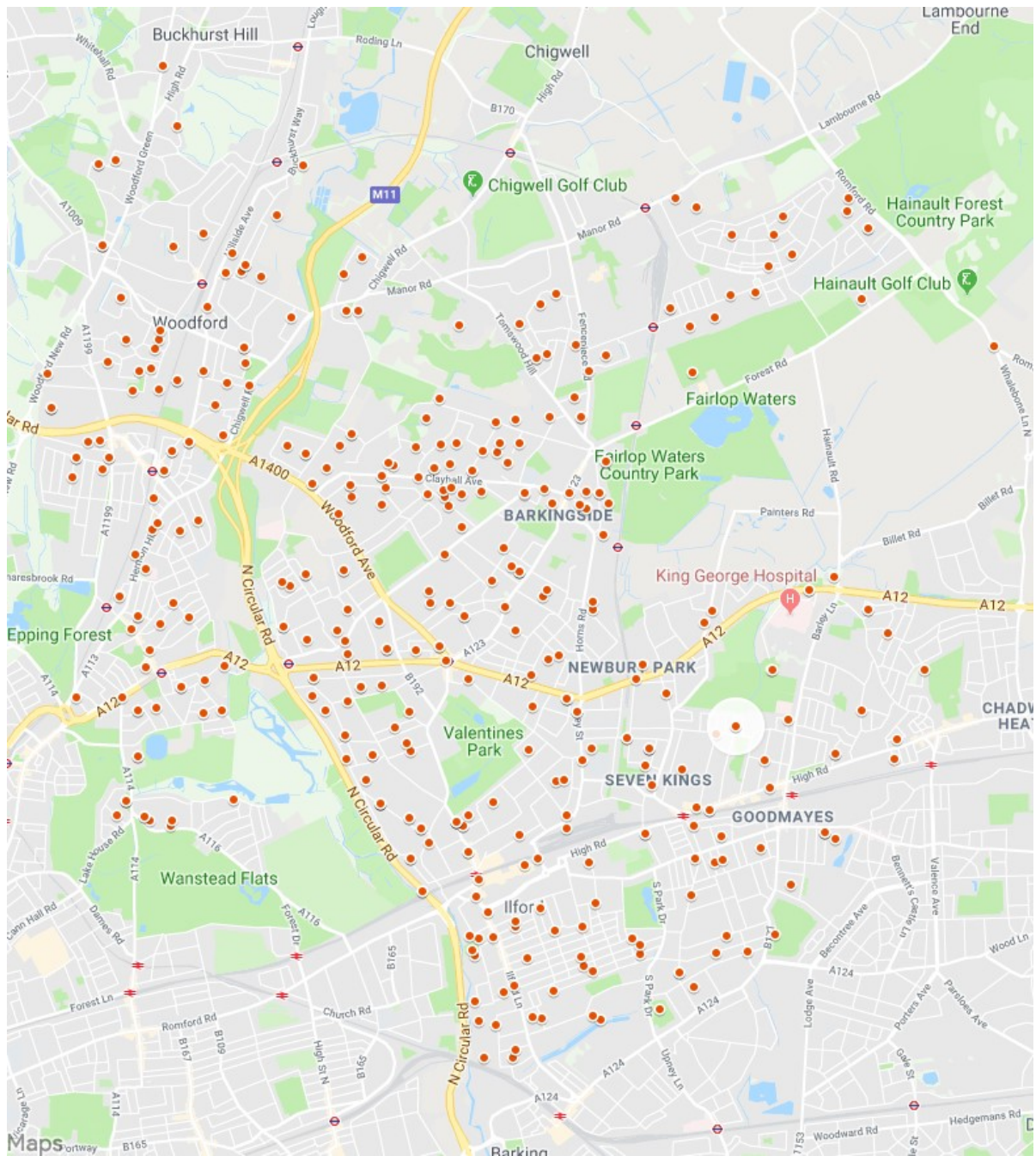

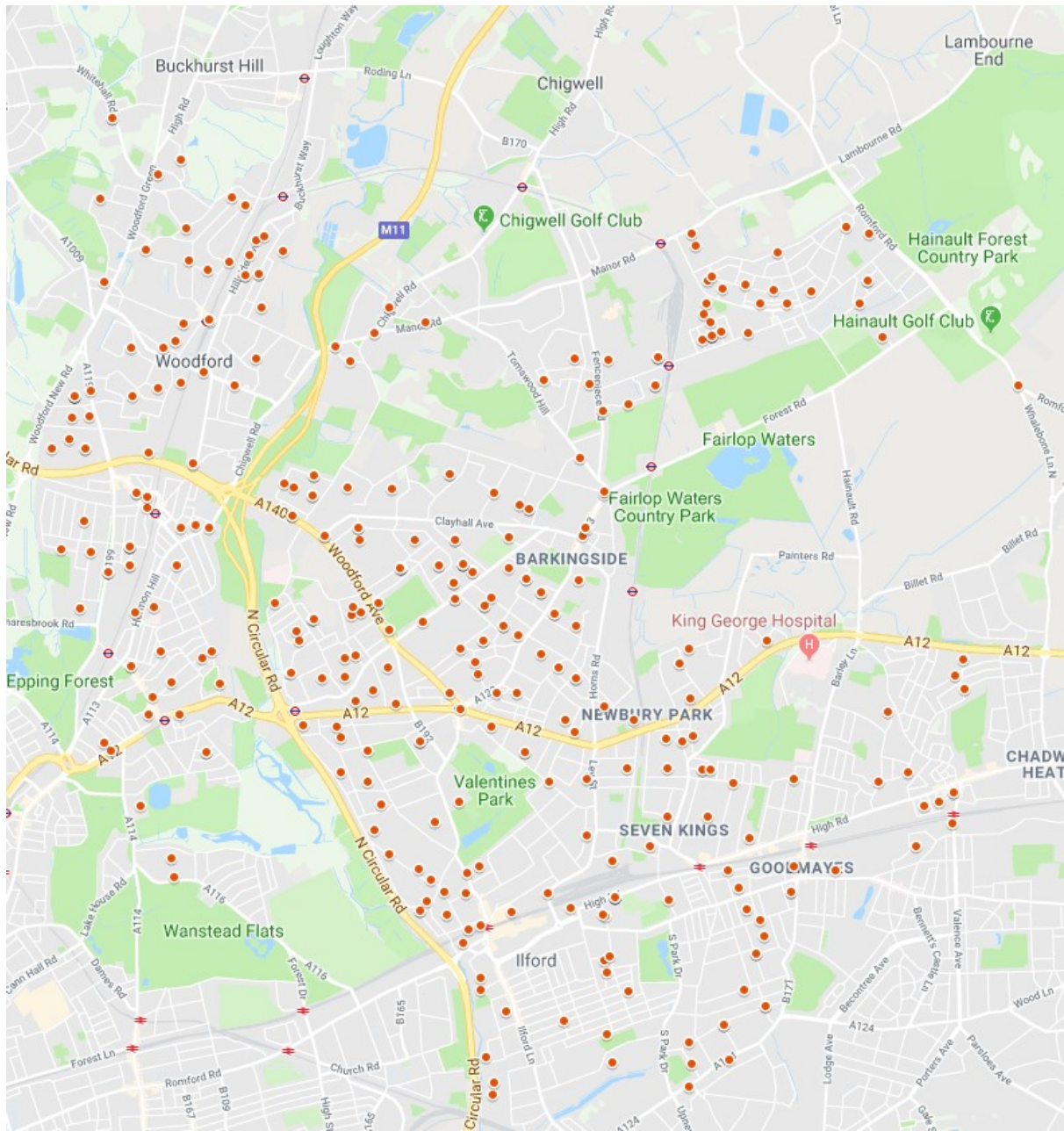

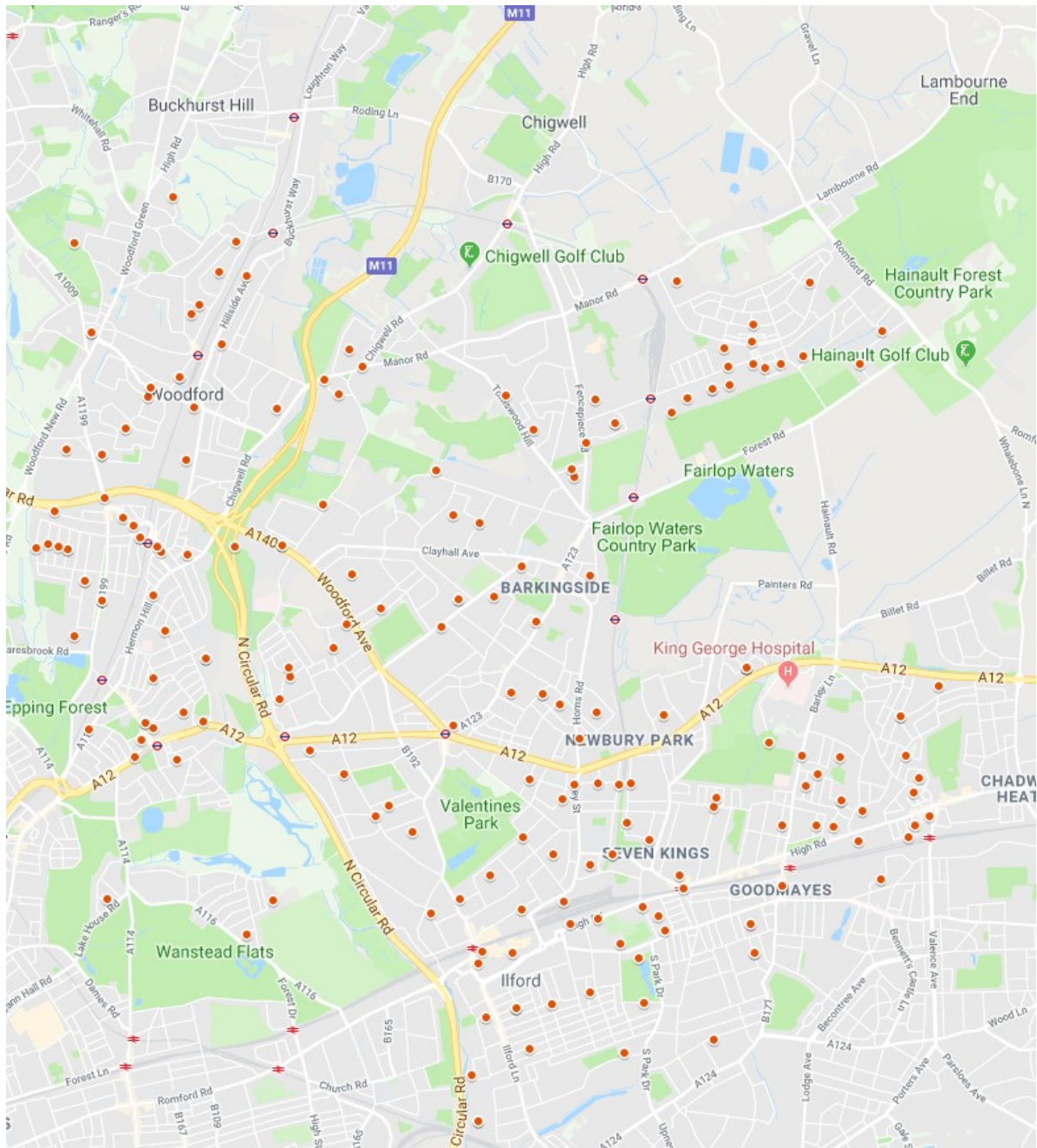

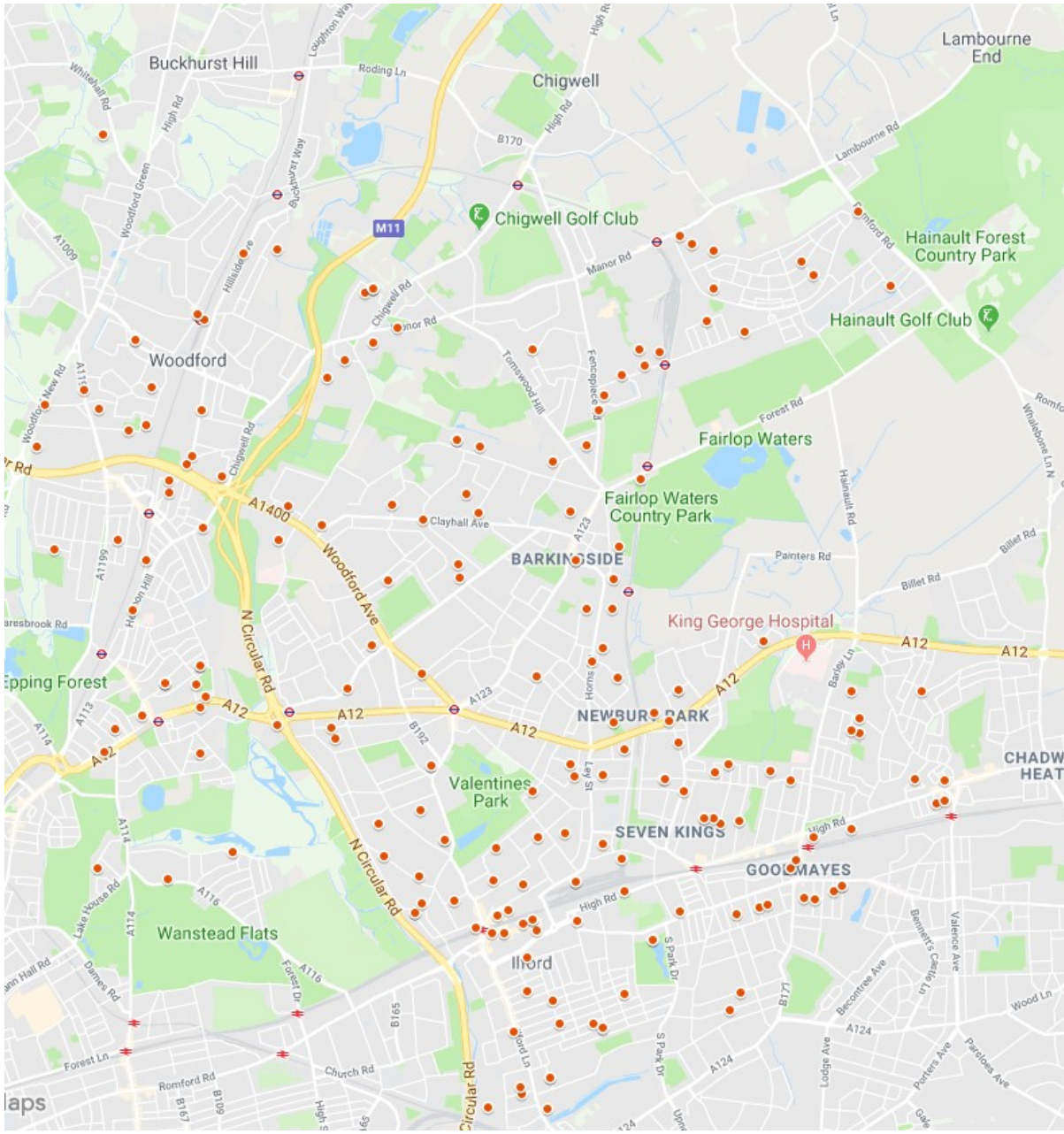

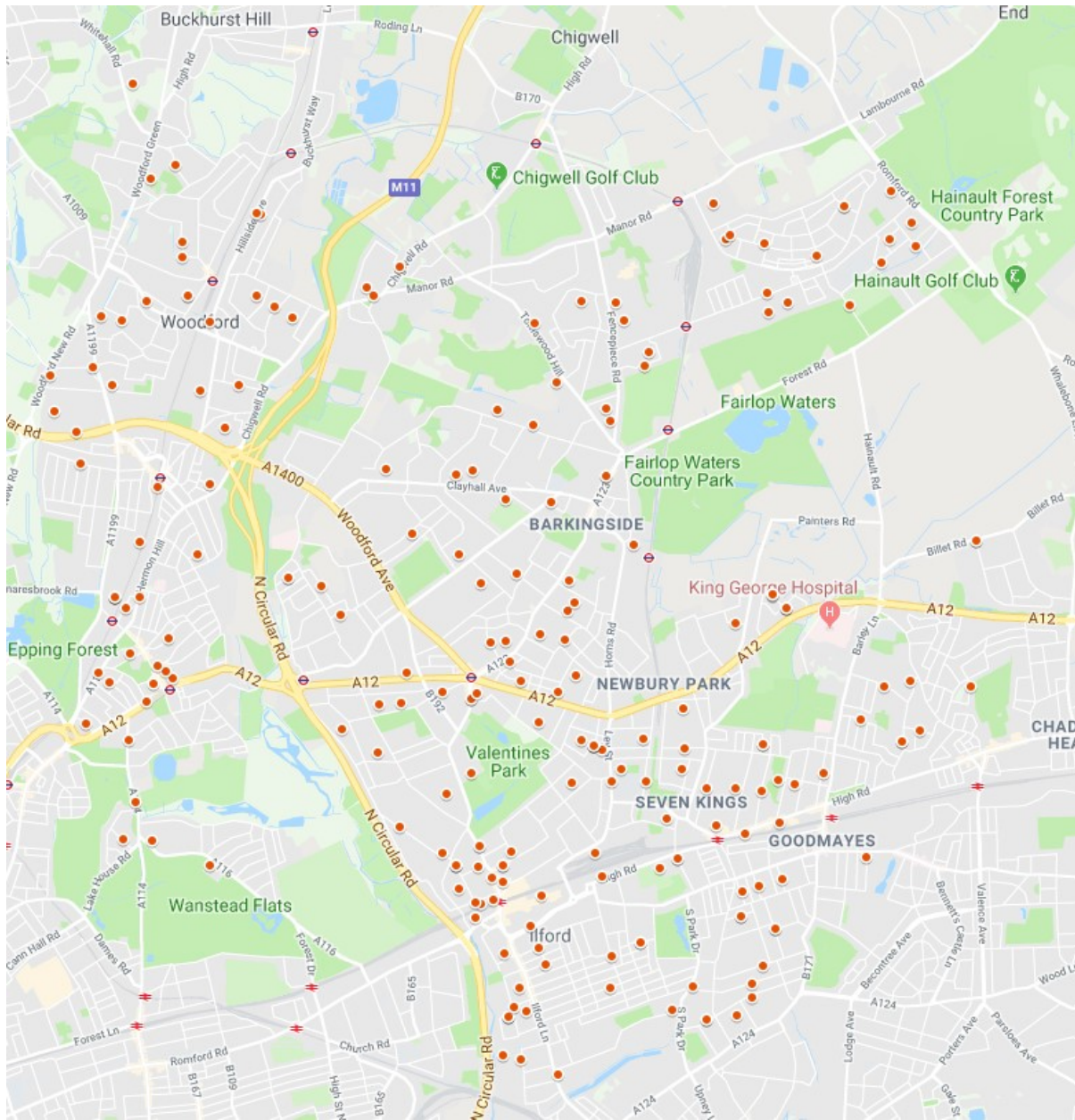

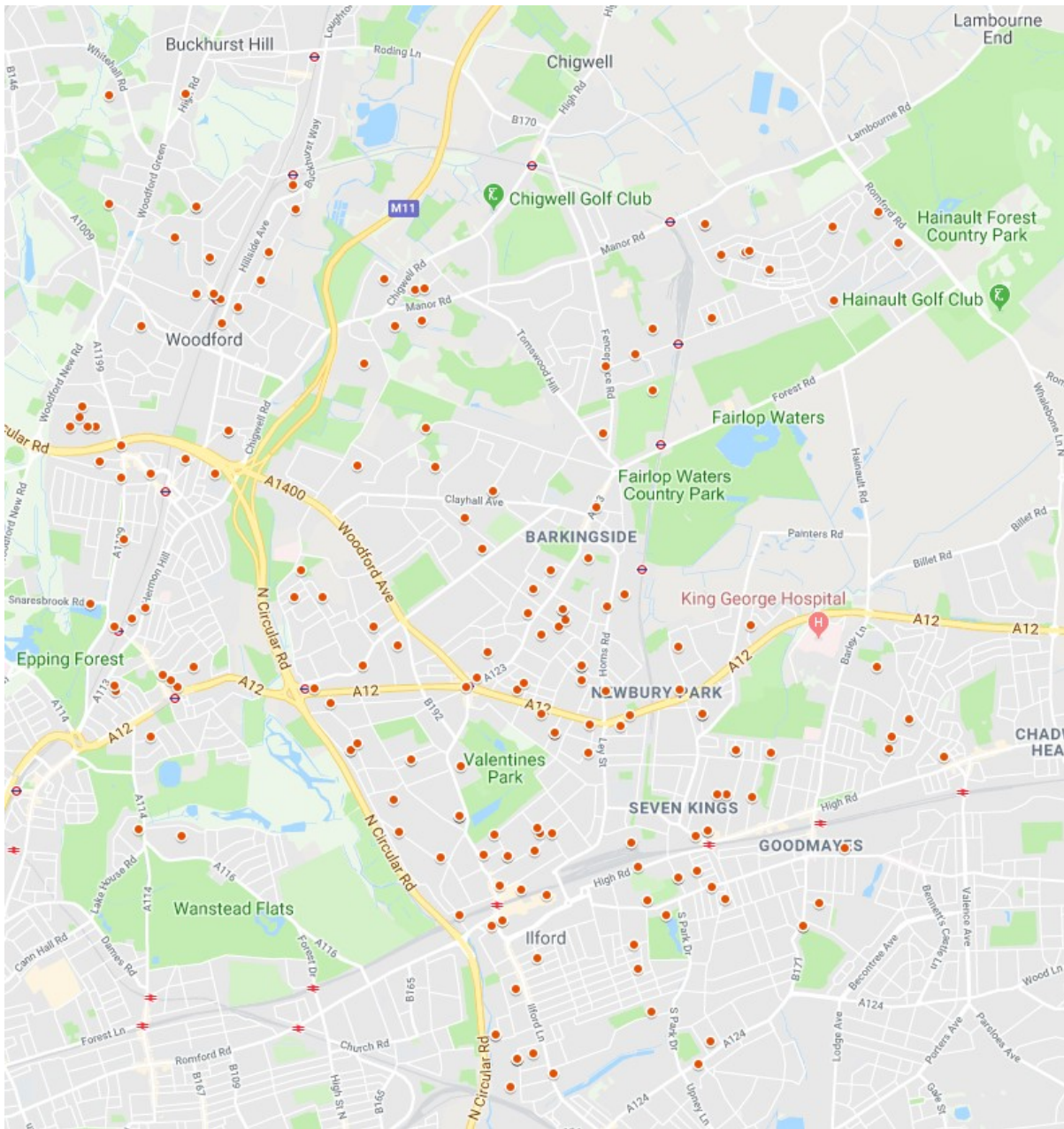

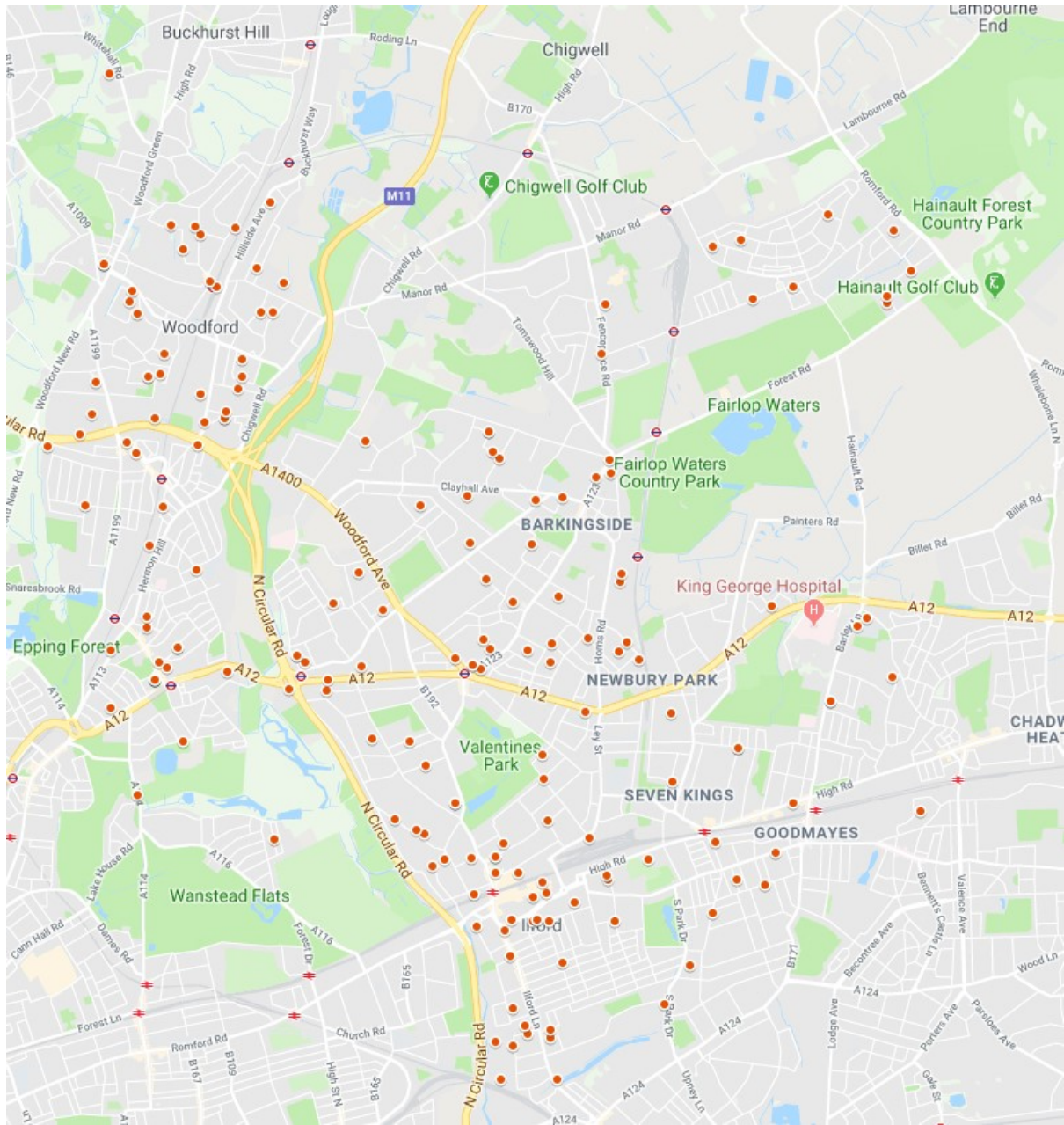

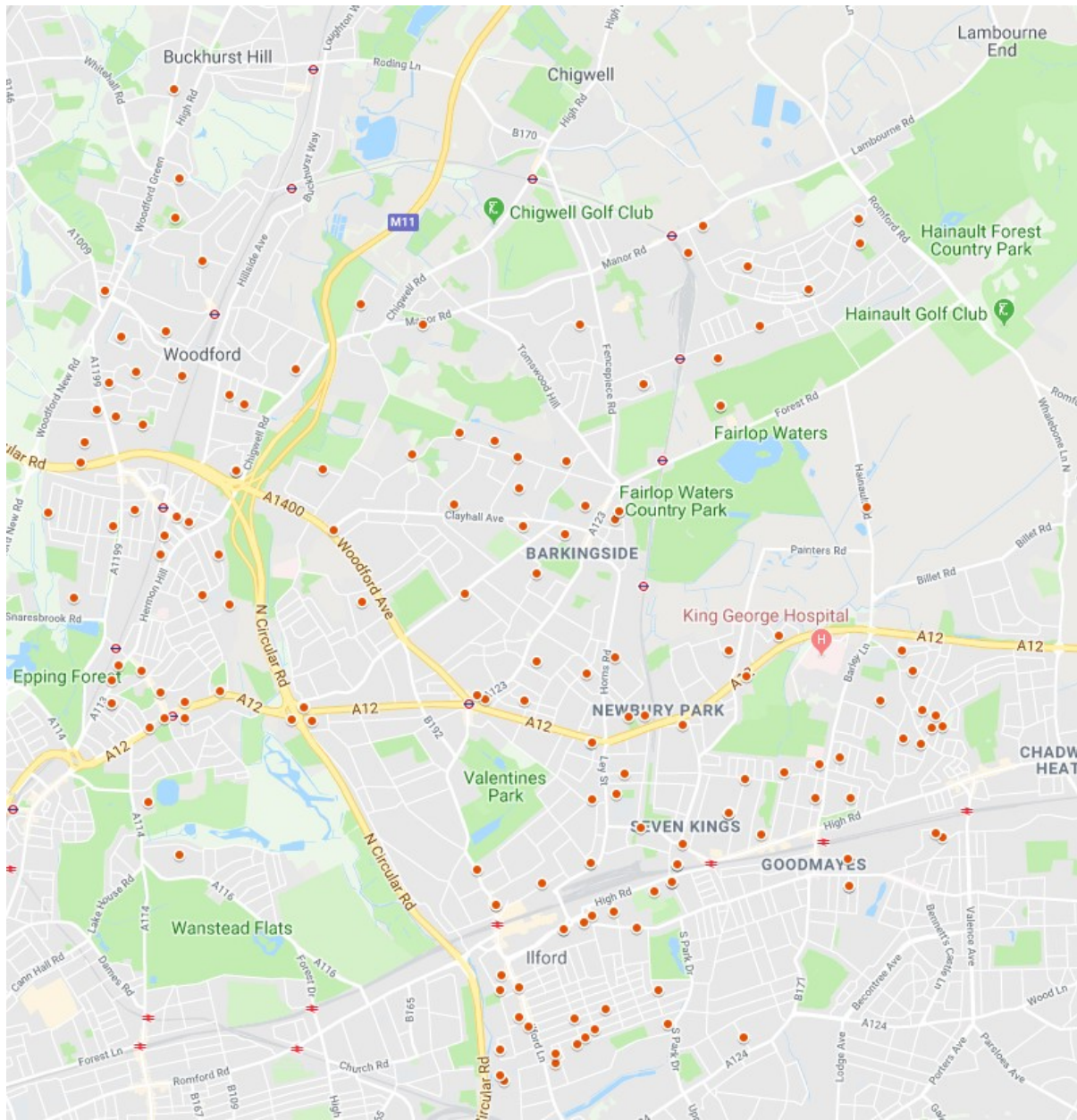

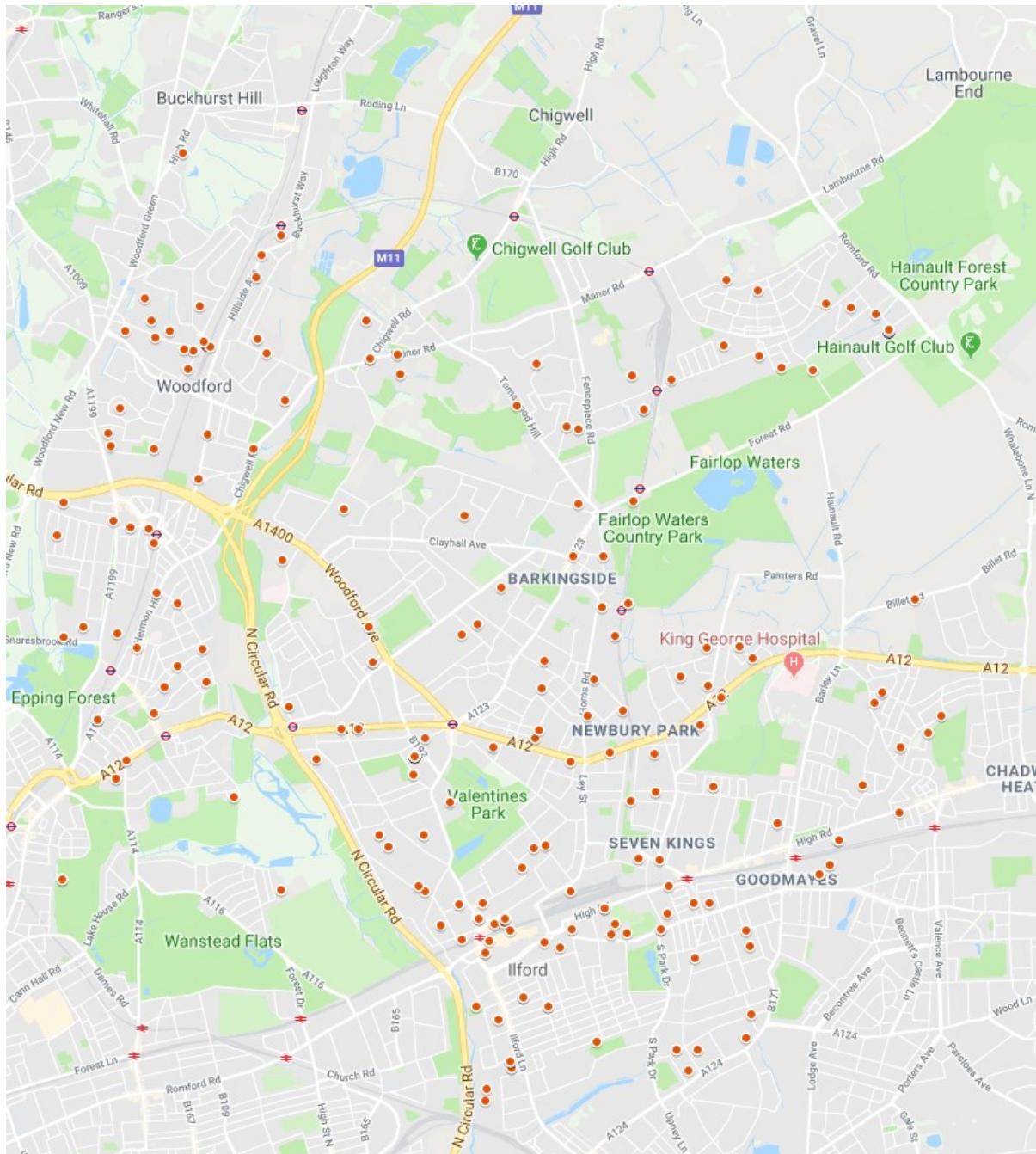

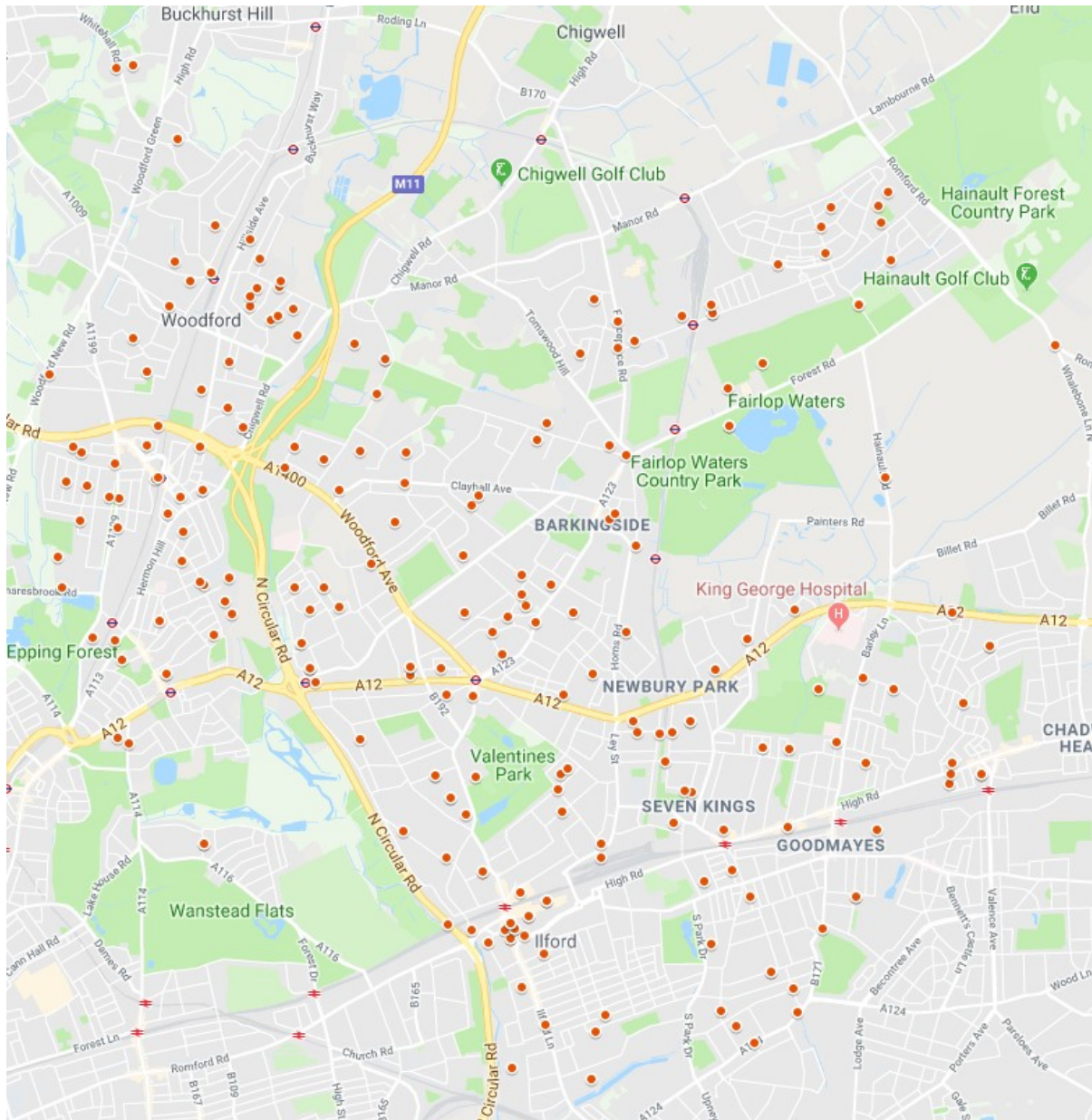

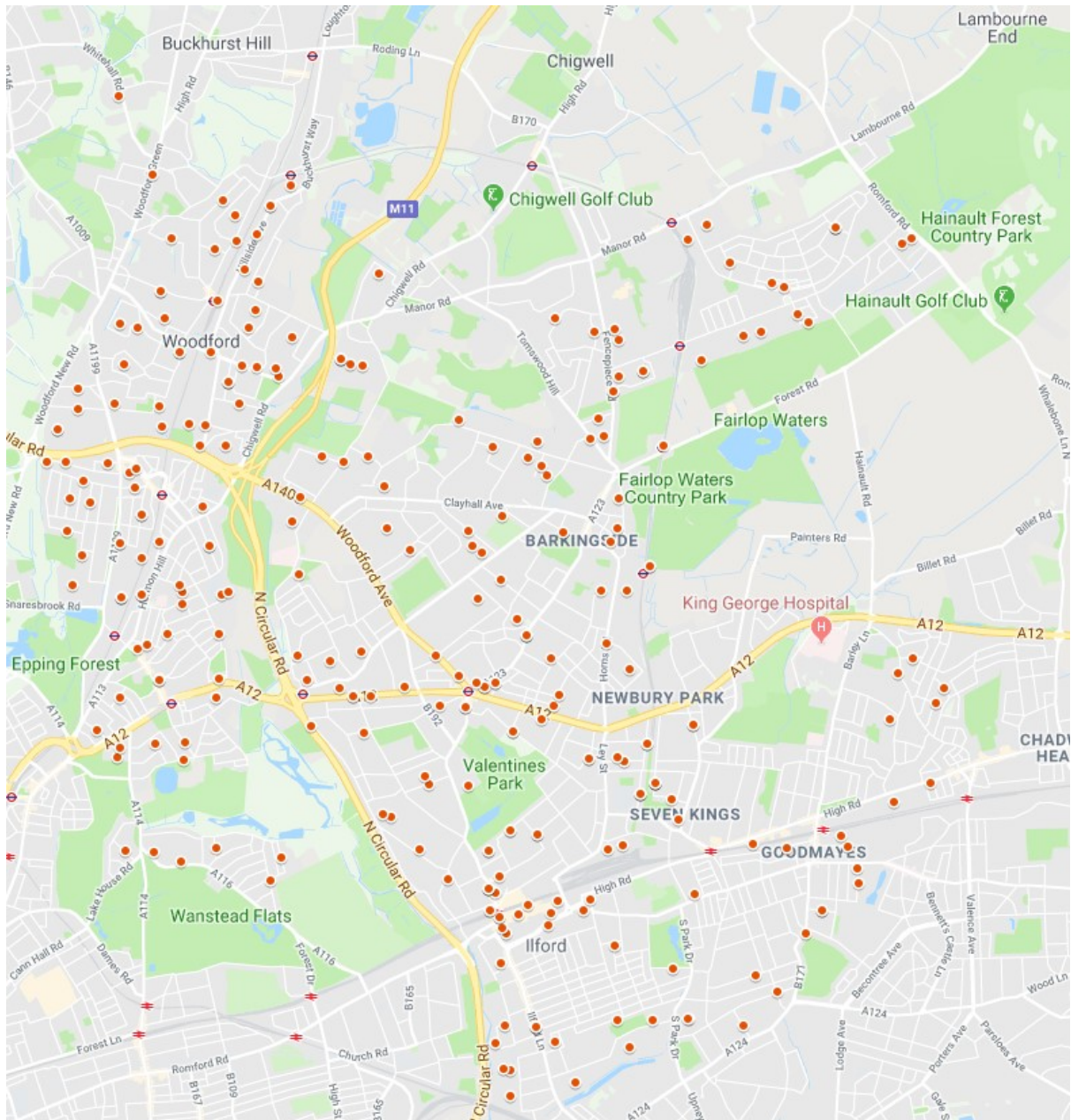
